Bruce Kopp asked about the disparity in the values of the bus trade ins. Assistant Superintendent Van Horn shared that there is little interest in 48 passenger school buses from Matthews Buses. Moving forward, we will not purchase any more 48 passenger school buses. However, we are getting higher trade in values on our 66 passenger buses than we used to because of how we take care of them.

-- <u>Retirement Incentive</u>: the Board of Education will offer a retirement incentive to all age-eligible employees meeting the criteria listed below, in the amount of \$10,000 to teachers and \$5,000 to teaching assistants. Regular full-time eligible employees who desire to take advantage of the Retirement Incentive must submit an irrevocable letter of resignation to the Superintendent of Schools in writing no later than 4:00 p.m. on or before March 19, 2021.

- Eligibility for receipt of undiminished retirement benefits from New York State Teachers' Retirement System; and
- Minimum age 55 years at the time of retirement; and
- At least thirty (30) years of credit in the New York State Teachers' Retirement System and at least thirty (30) years of continuous service in the Southern Cayuga Central School District immediately preceding retirement.

Or

- Minimum age of 55 years at the time of retirement; and
- The total of the employee's chronological age and years of service at Southern Cayuga Central School District immediately preceding retirement equals 80 years or more.

Bruce Kopp asked why the budget code is called "Guidance Testing 7-12", when the SAT exams are for 11th and 12th grade students. Assistant Superintendent Van Horn explained that the budget code is a standardized budget code, grades 7 and 8 are not separated out for Guidance testing materials.

Superintendent Jensen shared that over 200 individuals were able to obtain their first vaccine dose on 2/4/2021 from a Covid-19 vaccine clinic the Cayuga County Health Department offered here. We currently have a 70% staff vaccination rate.

Dave Harvatine expressed great frustration with King & King Architects, stemming from many questions that were unanswered during the 2/4/2021 Facilities Committee meeting.
