HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Southern Cayuga Central School District Board of Education authorizes the necessary funds for the July 1, 2020, to June 30, 2023, Agreement between the Southern Cayuga Central School District and the Southern Cayuga Administrators' Association.

- -- Abolishment of Elementary Teaching Positions: In creating the budget for the 2020/2021 school year, the Board of Education has determined that for reasons of economy and budgetary constraints, hereby abolishes three full-time (3.0 FTE) positions in the Elementary tenure area, effective June 30, 2020.
- -- <u>Abolishment of Support Staff Positions</u>: In creating the budget for the 2020/2021 school year, the Board of Education has determined that for reasons of economy and budgetary constraints, hereby abolishes support staff positions, representing 3.0 FTE Teacher Aide positions, effective June 30, 2020.
