Yearly Timeline

Nomination deadline – Oct. 15th

Review pool of candidates- Oct. 16 – Nov. 14th

Yearly honorees announced and invited – Nov. 15th

Yearly ceremony – January

Candidate Categories/ criteria for selection

Athlete

- 1) Must have competed in more than one varsity sport, unless in a unique situation they excelled highly in one sport.
- 2) A minimum of 5 years since they graduated from SCCS.
- 3) Exhibited extraordinary dedication to athletics and community, demonstrated leadership, set records/ won awards.

Coach

- 1) Must have coached a minimum of 10 years for SCCS and have been separated from the district for at least 2 years.
- 2) The coach must have won numerous division, league, sectional, regional and/or state titles.
- 3) The coach must have exhibited sportsmanship and coached with honesty, integrity and fairness and expected this from their players.

Teams

- 1) A team must have a minimum of ten years since the year in which it achieved its success.
- 2) Must have achieved championship status in either league, sectional, regional or state competition during a season or seasons.

Contributors

- 1) It must be shown that the contributions improved the program.
- 2) The contributor must demonstrate that they gave freely of their time, finances or expertise to support the SCCS athletic program.

People may be honored posthumous for any of the categories.

The SCCS Athletic Hall of Fame committee shall be comprised of members of the athletic committee.
